

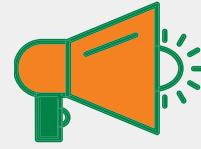


The Community Bank's Junior Board is a dynamic high school group of twelve juniors and seniors immersed in the business of banking, leadership, financial literacy and community service.
