### UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS

- CRT Monitors
- Thermostats/Mercury switch
- Equipment containing bio-waste, chemicals, oils/fluids, radioactive waste, asbestos or PCBs.
- Equipment with tanks or sealed units
- Light bulbs
- Cans of Paint
